

BIO-MEDICAL WASTE MANAGEMENT RULES, 2016

FAQs :

Q	What is Health Care Facility?
Ans	As per the BMW Rules health care facility means a place where diagnosis, treatment or immunisation of human beings or animals is provided irrespective of type and size of health treatment system, and research activity pertaining thereto.
Q	Who require authorisation under Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 ?
Ans	As per the Rule 10 of BMW Rules, every Health Care Facility i.e., occupier or operator handling Bio Medical Waste irrespective of the quantity such as hospitals, nursing homes, clinics, dispensaries, veterinary institutions, animal houses, pathological laboratories, blood banks, ayush hospitals, clinical establishments, research or educational institutions, health camps, medical or surgical camps, vaccination camps, blood donation camps, first aid rooms of schools, forensic laboratories and research labs shall obtain authorisation of the Board.
Q	What are duties of occupier of Health Care Facility (HCF)
Ans	<p>All the HCFs irrespective of quantity of Bio-Medical Waste generation shall obtain authorisation under Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.</p> <p>Conduct training to their staff on proper segregation, collection & storage of BMW.</p> <p>Segregate the Bio-Medical Wastes as per the colour coding (Yellow, Red, White & Blue) for proper disposal.</p> <p>The Bio-Medical Waste shall not be mixed with Municipal / General Waste.</p> <p>Segregated Bio-Medical Waste shall be stored in a safe, ventilated and secured location to avoid secondary handling, pilferage of recyclables.</p> <p>The segregated waste shall be to CBMWTF on daily basis or within 48 Hours.</p> <p>Inform the concerned Regional Officer of the Board in case the concerned CBMWTF is not lifted the Bio-Medical Waste within 48 Hours.</p> <p>Major HCFs having bed strength of more than 25 beds shall obtain consents of the Board under Water & Air Acts.</p>
Q	How to apply for BMW Authorisation?
Ans	The HCFs shall apply for authorisation under BMW Rules, 2016 through online at TSPCB portal (http://tsocmms.nic.in).
Q	What is the application procedure ?
Ans	The application in Form – II is to be submitted online for BMW Authorisation through Online Consent Management and Monitoring System (OCMMS). The concerned Regional Office of TSPCB inspects the Health Care Establishment (HCE) and process the applications at Regional Office level as per the delegated powers OR furnishes the inspection report to the Zonal Office/Head Office for processing the application of BMW Authorisation.

Q	What is the fee to be paid ?	
Ans	<p>The BMW Authorisation fee prescribed as per G.O. Ms. No. 41 of EFS&T Department, dt. 20.04.2005 is as follows:</p> <p>A fee of Rs. 100/- per bed per annum for fresh authorisations and fee of Rs. 50/- per bed per annum for renewal of authorisations shall be paid by the HCEs and in case of clinics with less than 10 beds, pathological laboratories, blood banks, clinics etc a flat charge of Rs. 1,000/- per annum towards processing fee shall be paid by every person who has control any institution generating bio-medical wastes, which includes a hospital, nursing home, clinic dispensary, veterinary institution, animal house, pathological laboratory and blood banks etc.</p>	
Q	Who will issued the BMW Authorisation?	
Ans	The Member Secretary / Zonal Officer / Regional Officer of the Board shall grant the BMW Authorisation as per the delegation of powers.	
Q	How to dispose the Bio-Medical Waste?	
Ans	The Bio-Medical Waste shall be segregated as per the colour coding (Yellow, Red, White & Blue). The segregated waste shall be disposed to concerned Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility operating in the area, on daily basis.	
Q	What are the Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facilities operating in Telangana?	
Ans	Hyderabad and Rangareddy districts. (4 CBMWTFs)
