Sub : TSPCB – Ease of Doing Business – Online Consent Management and Monitoring System (OCMMS) for processing consent applications under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and applications for HW Authorization under Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008 – Executive Instructions Issued - Reg.

The Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP) has introduced 'Ease of Doing Business', wherein it is mandated to design and implement an online system for processing applications for Consent for Establishment (CFE) and Consent for Operation (CFO) under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and applications for HW Authorization under Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008. As per the mandate, the system should allow online application, payment, tracking & monitoring without the need for a physical touch point for document submission and verification. It is also mandated that the system should allow users to download the final signed approval certificate from the online portal.

The NIC, New Delhi developed "Online Consent Management and Monitoring System" (OCMMS) for the Board for online processing of applications for Consent for Establishment (CFE) and Consent for Operation (CFO) under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and applications for Hazardous Waste Authorization (HWA) under Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008. The OCMMS system allows the following:

- Online submission of application for CFE, CFO & HWA.
- Online payment of consent fee (through ICICI Payment Gateway)
- Online tracking and monitoring
- Document submission and verification without the need for a physical touch point.
- Allows the users to download the final signed approval certificate from the online portal.

The OCMMS software was launched by the Board on 23.09.2015 in the presence of Board Officials and representatives of Industries and Industrial Associations. The salient features of the software were demonstrated by the representatives of NIC, Delhi. The industries were requested to submit CFE, CFO & HWA applications through OCMMS. The ROs & ZOs were directed to start implementation of the software.

In view of the above, all the Regional Officers, Zonal Officers and Divisional Heads at Head Office are instructed to implement OCMMS for processing applications for Consent for Establishment (CFE) and Consent for Operation (CFO) under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and applications for HW Authorization under Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008. The ROs are instructed not to accept any application and documents in physical form. Online applications and documents filed through OCMMS shall only be accepted.
