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1. **WHEREAS**, you are operating the industry in the name of M/s. Vasanth Seed Processing Plant, Sy. No. 524, 525, Amisthapur (V), Bhoothpur (M), Mahabubnagar District which is involved in De-linting of cotton seed.
2. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 1st cited, the EE, RO, Hyderabad has forwarded detail inspection report to Zonal office, Hyderabad for taking necessary action on De-linting units, but RO, Hyderabad has not received further action status of the industries.
3. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 2nd cited, the Zonal Office, Hyderabad issued directions to the industry to comply with the following conditions within 15 days.
 - The industry shall immediately apply for CFO for delinting activity which they are operating without having consent of the Board.
 - The industry shall not discharge effluents, directly into unlined lagoons.
 - The industry shall not store effluents in unlined lagoon
 - The industry shall not store acid carboys in open area without concentrate floor.
 - The industry shall provide closed shed for storage of Sulphuric Acid Carboys
 - The industry shall submit the details pertaining to production and wastes disposed to JETL & TSDF.
 - The industry shall not store hazardous wastes in unlined open areas.
4. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 3rd cited, the AEE-III of RO, Hyderabad has inspected De-linting units located at Bhoothpur Mandal on 07.01.2020. The general and inspection observations of the following industries are as below:
 1. The industry M/s Vasanth Seed Processing Plant, Sy No 524, 525, Amisthapur (v), Bhoothpur (M), Mahabubnagar District and involved in De-linting of cotton seed.

2. The industry has not obtained CFO /CFE of the Board.
 3. The industry was in operation & Sri Murali, Plant Incharge of the industry was present.
 4. The industry is discharging effluents, directly into unlined lagoon.
 5. The industry has stored effluents unlined lagoon and stagnated effluents were observed in the unlined lagoon which is adjacent to Natural nala.
 6. The industry has stored acid carboys in open area.
 7. The industry has not provided closed shed for storage of Sulphuric Acid.
 8. The industry has not obtained member ship of M/s. JETL for lifting the waste water.
 9. The industry has not obtained member ship of M/s. TSDF for lifting sludge.
 10. The Board Officials have collected samples from Stagnated effluents collected from unlined lagoon for analysis. As per the analysis reports, the samples collected is acidic in nature, so BOD parameter was not carried out. The other parameters are pH - 1.08, TSS - 1,162 mg/lit, TDS - 2 0,854 mg/lit and COD - 7,290mg/lit.
5. **WHEREAS**, the EE, Regional Office, Hyderabad has forwarded a detailed report with the above observations to Zonal Office Hyderabad for further necessary action vide reference 4th cited.
6. **WHEREAS** vide reference 5th cited above, the Zonal Office, Hyderabad has conducted Legal Hearing before the Zonal office, Task Force Committee meeting held on 31.01.2020 at Zonal Office, T.S Pollution Control Board, Begumpet, Hyderabad. After detailed discussions and careful consideration of material facts of the case, the committee recommended **to issue closure orders** to the industry for the following reasons:
- The industry is operating without obtaining CFO /CFE of the Board.
 - The industry is directly discharging the effluents into unlined lagoon.
 - The industry has stored effluents unlined lagoon and stagnated effluents were observed in the unlined lagoon which is adjacent to Natural nala.
 - The industry has stored acid carboys in open area.
 - The industry has not provided closed shed for storage of Sulphuric Acid.
 - The industry has not obtained member ship of M/s. JETL for lifting the waste water.
 - The industry has not obtained member ship of M/s. TSDF for lifting sludge.
 - The industry is not complying the conditions stipulated vide order dated 26.03.2019.
 - As per the analysis reports of samples collected from stagnated effluents from unlined lagoon, the values are exceeding the prescribed standards.
7. After careful consideration of all material facts of the case and the recommendation of the Task Force Committee, the Board has observed that the industry is not complying with the directions and conditions of the Board and causing nuisance to the surrounding people

thereby causing severe water pollution in the surrounding area thereby affecting the public health and environment.

8. Under the Powers vested with the T.S. Pollution Control Board under section 33(A) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and under 31(A) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987 for the reasons stated above, **the Board hereby issues closure orders to your industry**, in the interest of protecting public health and environment.
9. You are further directed to note that the TSCPDCL has been ordered to disconnect Power Supply to your plant with immediate effect. Should you resort to run your industry by means of diesel generator or any mechanical device, you will be attracting prosecution under Section 41(2) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and under Section 37(1) of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987.

The orders will take effect from today i.e., **07.02.2020**

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Under the powers vested under section 33(A) of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and under section 31(A) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987, the TSPDCL is hereby directed by TS Pollution Control Board to disconnect the Power supply to M/s. **Vasanth Seed Processing Plant, Sy. No. 524, 525, Amisthapur (V), Bhoothpur (M), Mahabubnagar District** with effect from the date of this order.

The T.S Pollution Control Board has issued closure orders to M/s. **Vasanth Seed Processing Plant, Sy. No. 524, 525, Amisthapur (V), Bhoothpur (M), Mahabubnagar District** under section 33(A) of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and under section 31(A) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987, the industry is not complying with the directions and conditions of the Board and causing nuisance to the surrounding people thereby causing severe water pollution in the surrounding area thereby affecting the public health and environment.
