No. 296/7/7, IDA, Bollaram, Jinnaram Mandal, Sangareddy District - Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 - Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987 - Accident occurred in the industry premises - Non compliance of the Board directions - CLOSURE ORDERS - ISSUED - Reg.**

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1. **WHEREAS**, you are operating the industry located at Sy. No. 296/7/7, IDA, Bollaram, Jinnaram Mandal, Sangareddy District.
2. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited, the Board has issued CFO&HWA order vide order dt: 25.03.2017 for manufacture Distillation and Recovery of solvents-Toluene / Acetone / Ethyl Acetate / IPA - 1000 LPD, Piperazine Anhydrous from 65% of Crude Piperazine - 500 Kg/day and Piperazine Hydrate from 65% of Crude Piperazine - 300 Kg/day with a validity period upto 31.10.2021.
3. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited, an adverse news item appeared in "EENADU" news daily on 17.11.2017 with a caption "Matthu Makili" regarding manufacturing of Narcotic drugs.
4. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited, the Board issued Closure Orders to the industry vide order dt:07.12.2017 dispensing the opportunity of hearing, for non-compliances of CFO & HWA conditions i.e., the industry has manufactured un consented product Trytyl Chloride 10.5 Tons, Ether - 10.5 Tons against the NIL permitted. The industry is doing job work for M/s SMS Pharma Ltd, M/s Sruthi organics LTD, Solapur, M/s shiva sai chemtech, Prashanthnagar, M/s Vani Pharma Labs, M/s Srikara Organics Ltds., M/s A.R Life Sciences Jeedimetla etc,. The industry has not produced any documents regarding manufacturing of Narcotic drugs.
5. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited, the Board issued Temporary Revocation of Closure order to your industry on 28.10.2019 for a period of Three Months with certain directions to comply with.
6. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 5<sup>th</sup> cited, the Board vide order dt.31.01.2020 has directed the industry to pay Rs. 25.0 Lakh (Rs. Twenty Five Lakhs only) towards Environmental Compensation as an interim compensation pending assessment, as per the Hon'ble NGT order dt: 10.07.2019.
7. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 6<sup>th</sup> cited, the Board has issued Extension of Temporary Revocation of Closure Orders to the industry on 04.03.2020 for a period upto 31.08.2020 with certain directions to comply.
8. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 7<sup>th</sup> cited, the Board has received telephonic information from R/o Bollaram area on 21.05.2020 at around 6.30 PM regarding Fire accident occurred in the industry.
9. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 8<sup>th</sup> cited, the Board Officials along with night patrolling team inspected the industry and its surroundings on 21.05.2020 at around 7.00 P.M. and following observations were made:
  1. During inspection, Sri. Srinivas, District Fire Officer, Sangareddy District and Team, local Press reporters (Electronic & Print Media), Villagers of Bollaram were present.
  2. As per the information given by villagers of Bollaram and local people the fire accident was occurred in the industry at around 6.00 PM on 21.05.2020 and the villagers of Bollaram informed that there is no causality in fire accident and three workers/employees of the industry were injured.

3. The fire department rescue team has carried out water spraying and fire was completely controlled by using one fire tender.
  4. The Production block is completely damaged and collapsed due to the fire accident. The fire was not spreaded towards Solvent drums storage shed having about 50 Nos of Solvent Drums and coal fired vertical boiler of capacity 0.5 TPH due to which they have not effected and damaged.
  5. Due to the accident the smoke has spread towards surroundings causing increase in Particular Matter Levels in the Ambient atmosphere which was observed in the continuous monitoring station situated at Bollaram.
  6. During inspection at 8.00 to 8.30 PM the Board officials have recorded the VOC readings in and around the industry premises and the VOC values are observed to be in the range of 0.4 PPM to 2.3 PPM.
  7. The industry representative informed that, the fire accident occurred in one of the process reactor during recovery of crude Pyperazine and spreaded in the process shed. Department of factories will investigate and ascertain actual cause of accident and casualties/ injuries in the accident.
10. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 9<sup>th</sup> cited, the Board issued Show Cause Notice to the industry on 22.05.2020 directing to collect the entire contaminated waste in the premises generated during fire and also to collect top layer soil contaminated with solvents/residues and send to TSDF, Dindigal for treatment and disposal.
  11. After careful consideration of the material facts of the case, the Board is of the firm opinion that the industry has not taken safety measures for prevention of accident, not complying with the consent conditions / directions issued by the Board and causing pollution in the surrounding area. In view of likelihood of further grave injury to the environment and public health if the industry continues to operate, the Board decided to dispense with opportunity of hearing and issue closure orders to the industry. Under the Powers vested with the T.S. Pollution Control Board under section 32 and 33 (A) of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and under section 31(A) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987 for the reasons stated above, the **Board hereby issues closure orders to your industry** in the interest of protecting public health and environment. You are also hereby directed to stop all industrial activities with immediate effect from the date of this order.
  12. You are directed to take note that if you continue to operate your industry even after receipt of these orders, you will be liable for prosecution in the court of Metropolitan Magistrate or Judicial Magistrate of the first class under section 41(2) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) and Amendment Act, 1988 and under section 37 (1) of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987 the punishment for which includes imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than one year six months which may be extended to six years and with fine.
  13. You are further directed to take note that the TSSPDCL, has been ordered to disconnect Power Supply to your industry with immediate effect. Should you resort to run your industry by means of diesel generator or any mechanical device, you will be attracting prosecution under section 41(2) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and under section 37 (1) of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987.

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The Telangana State Pollution Control Board vide reference cited above issued Closure Orders to **M/s Sree Harsha Organics, Sy. No. 296/7/7, IDA, Bollaram, Jinnaram Mandal, Sangareddy District** for not taken safety measures for prevention of accident, under section 33(A) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and under section 31 (A) of Air (Prevention and control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987. A copy of the closure order is herewith enclosed.

In view of the above, as per the powers vested under Section 33 (A) of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and under Section 31 (A) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987, the Telangana State Southern Power Distribution Company Ltd. is hereby directed **to disconnect the power supply to M/s Sree Harsha Organics, Sy. No. 296/7/7, IDA, Bollaram, Jinnaram Mandal, Sangareddy District.**
