### DIRECTIONS

Sub: TSPCB, ZO, R.C.Puram – M/s. Paragon Polymer Products Pvt. Ltd., Plot No. 19, Phase – I, IDA, Patancheru, Sangareddy District – Complaints received from M/s. ICRISAT, Patancheru and nearby residential area regarding smell nuisance in their area due to release of emissions by the industries – **Directions – Issued – Reg.**

**WHEREAS** you are operating the industry in the name of M/s. Paragon Polymer Products Pvt. Ltd., Plot No. 19, Phase – I, IDA, Patancheru, Sangareddy District.

**WHEREAS** vide ref. 1<sup>st</sup> cited, the Board has issued CFO & HWA to your industry for manufacture of Hawai Chappals – 750 TPM, MC (Hawai) sheet waste powder – 360 TPM & Parts of foot wear – 30 Lakhs pairs /Annum with certain conditions with a validity period upto 30.06.2021.

**WHEREAS** vide ref. 2<sup>nd</sup> cited, Telephonic complaints were received from M/s. ICRISAT, Patancheru and nearby residential area regarding rubber & chemical smell nuisance in their surroundings and causing health hazard for the staff and scientists of the institute as well as the families residing in the campus and villagers.

**WHEREAS** vide reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited, the Board officials inspected your industry and during the inspection, the following observations were made:

1. During the inspection the industry was in operation.
2. The industry is not operating scrubber- II attached to the sheet pressing unit – 1, 2 & 6.
3. The industry has not provided connections to the scrubbers attached to the sheet pressing unit – 5.
4. Pungent rubber smell was observed near and within sheet pressing and curing process shed, thereby causing odour nuisance to the surroundings.
5. Characteristic rubber smell was observed near embossing and cutting sections.
6. The VOC values recorded were observed up to 4.6 PPM - 25.0 PPM inside the sheet pressing and curing process shed, which indicates odour nuisance to the surroundings.
7. The industry has not provided adequate air pollution control systems to control the emissions and odour nuisance.

**WHEREAS**, vide reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited, the EE, RO, Sangareddy has issued a Show Cause Notice to your industry for the above violations and submitted a report to this office for taking suitable action on the above matter vide reference 5<sup>th</sup> cited.

**WHEREAS**, vide reference 6<sup>th</sup> cited, the case was placed for hearing before the External Advisory Committee of Zonal Office, TSPCB, R.C.Puram on 24.07.2020 and the committee observed that the unit is operating without taking adequate air pollution control measures creating air/odour pollution problems in the surrounding area. After detailed discussions, the committee recommended to issue certain directions to the industry to comply with.

After careful consideration of all the material facts of the case and as per the recommendations of the committee, the Board hereby issues the following directions to your industry within one month to comply with:

- i. The industry shall comply with all the conditions stipulated in the CFO order.
- ii. The industry shall regularly operate bag filters as Air Pollution Control Equipment to the rubber crushing section for controlling the dust emissions and shall be reused within main product.
- iii. The industry shall regularly operate all scrubbers attached to the sheet pressing units for controlling the dust and smell nuisance.
- iv. The industry shall provide connections to the scrubbers attached to the sheet pressing unit immediately.
- v. The industry shall take effective measures to control odour pollution near rubber crushing section & sheet pressing areas
- vi. The industry shall not cause any air pollution / dust nuisance / odour nuisance in the surrounding environment & residents under any circumstances.
- vii. The industry shall provide separate energy meter to the air pollution control system i.e., scrubbers and maintain a log register as per the meter readings.
- viii. The industry shall maintain a good house keeping in the premises.
- ix. The industry shall develop a minimum of 5 mtrs width green belt all around the boundary of the unit and in vacant places with tall growing trees with wide leaf area. The area allocated for greenbelt shall not be less than 33 % of total area of industry.

These directions are issued under Section 31(A) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987 and under section 33(A) of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 in the interest of protecting Public Health & Environment.

You are further directed to note that, if you operate the unit without complying with the above directions, the Board may issue closure orders under Section 31(A) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987 and Section 33(A) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988. Also you will be liable for prosecution under Section 37(1) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987 and section 41(2) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 in the interest of protecting public health and environment, without further notice.
