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WHEREAS you are operating the Health Care Facility (HCF) in the name of M/s. Sadguru Sai Ram Hospital Pvt. Ltd., Near Bus Stand Ali bagh Colony, Vikarabad District with 10 Nos. of beds strength.

WHEREAS, vide reference 1st cited, the Health Care Facility (HCF) has applied for Bio Medical Waste authorization for 10 beds.

WHEREAS, vide reference 2nd cited, the Board Officials inspected the HCF on 27.12.2019 and Dr Satyanarayana Goud was present and accompanied during inspection. During inspection, the following observations were made:

- The HCF is not following the Color Coding and Segregation as per Bio Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- The HCF not mutilating/shredding the needles.
- The HCF is not maintaining the register /records on day to day basis by the BMW generation and disposal.
- The HCF has not provided training programme to all its health care workers and others, involved in handling of Bio Medical waste as per Bio Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- The HCF has not provided safe ventilated secured location for storage of segregated Bio Medical Waste, thereby the HCF is violating the Bio Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- The HCF has not provided the Bar coding system for the bags or containers bio medical waste to be sent to the CBMWTF, thereby violating the Bio Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- The HCF has not formed committee to review and monitor.

WHEREAS, vide reference 3rd cited, a Notice was issued to the HCF for Non Compliance of Bio Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.

WHEREAS, vide reference 4th cited, the EE, Regional Office-I, Rangareddy District has forwarded a detailed report with the above observations to Zonal Office Hyderabad for further necessary action.

WHEREAS, vide reference 5th cited, the issue was discussed before the Task Force Committee meeting held on 03.01.2020 at TSPCB, Zonal Office, Hyderabad. After detailed discussions, the committee recommended to issue certain directions to comply within 15 days.

WHEREAS as per the recommendations of the committee, the Board hereby issues the following directions to comply within 15 days:

- i. The HCF shall provide Sewage Treatment Plant(STP). The HCF shall treat the disinfected washing effluents in STP along with domestic effluents.
- ii. The HCF shall follow the Color Coding and Segregation as per Bio Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- iii. Syringes should be either mutilated or needles should be cut and or stored in tamper proof, leak proof and puncture proof containers for sharps storage and dispose in the manner prescribed. Mutilation / shredding must be such so as to prevent unauthorised reuse.
- iv. The HCF shall maintain the register /records pertaining to the Bio Medical Waste generation and its disposal on day to day basis .
- v. The HCF shall provide training programme to all its health care workers and others, involved in handling of Bio Medical waste as per Bio Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- vi. The HCF shall provide safe ventilated secured location for storage of segregated Bio Medical Waste.
- vii. The HCF shall provide the Bar coding system for the bags or containers bio medical waste to be sent to the CBMWTF.
- viii. The HCF shall form committee to review and monitor the activities related to bio-medical waste management.

In view of the above, the HCF is hereby directed to comply with the above directions within 15 days. These directions are issued under Section 33(A) of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and under Section 31 (A) of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987.

It is also to note that, if it is continued to operate the unit violating any of the conditions mentioned above, the unit will be closed under Section 33(A) of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988, Section 31(A) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987 and you will also be liable for prosecution in the court of Metropolitan Magistrate or Judicial Magistrate of the first class under Section 41(2) of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) amendment Act, 1988, the punishment for which includes imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than one year six months and which may be extended to six years with fine.
