- I. Earlier, the SEIAA, TS issued EC order vide reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited for **2.751 Ha. Colour Granite Mine** in favour of **M/s. Tulip Granites Pvt. Ltd., Sy. No. 473, 483 & 484, Nagulamalyal (V), Kothapalli (M), Karimnagar District** for mining 1000 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Colour Granite Mine.
- II. The proponent vide reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited informed that the maximum production capacity is 19,822 m<sup>3</sup>/annum as per Approved Mining Plan. Hence, it was requested to issue Amendment to EC duly revising the production capacity from 1000 m<sup>3</sup>/annum to 19,822 m<sup>3</sup>/annum.
- III. The request of the proponent was examined by the State Level Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) in its meeting held on 09.01.2018. Based on the information furnished; the Committee considered the request of the proponent and recommended to issue amendment to the EC order. The State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), in its meeting held on 21.02.2018 examined the request of the proponent and the recommendations of SEAC, and decided to issue amendment to the Environmental Clearance. Hence, the following amendments are made to the EC order issued vide reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited:

(a) The mining capacity mentioned under Para no. I shall be read as:

**Mining of Colour Granite – 19,822 m<sup>3</sup>/annum.**

- IV. All other information mentioned and conditions stipulated in the EC order issued vide reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited remain the same.
