2. Your representation submitted online on 28.11.2016 received on 22.12.2016.

- I. Earlier, the SEIAA, AP (Combined State) had issued Environmental Clearance for the **12.774 Ha. Colour Granite Mine** in favour of **M/s. Geetha Sri Granites, Sy. No. 225, Maddutla (V), Malyal (M), Karimnagar District** vide reference 1st cited.
- II. The proponent vide reference 2nd cited submitted representation along with Form 1, EMP & Approved Mining Plan uploaded online on 28.11.2016 (proposal no. SIA/TG/MIN/17845/2013) received on 22.12.2016, seeking Amendment to Environmental Clearance. It was informed that they approached ADMG, Karimnagar for grant of Mining lease and they were informed that there was reclassification of lands by the District Collector and they should seek an Amendment in the mine lease. Accordingly, they amended the Mining Plan and obtained approval. The proponent also obtained work orders from the ADMG, Karimnagar vide Procds. dt.12.08.2014. Hence, the proponent requested to issue Amendment to the EC.
- III. The request of the proponent was examined by the State Level Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) in its meeting held on 31.12.2016. Based on the information furnished presentation made by the proponent and the consultant M/s. Team Labs and Consultants, Hyderabad; the Committee considered the request of the proponent and recommended to issue amendment to the EC order. The State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), in its meetings held on 27.01.2017 & 16.02.2017 examined the request of the proponent and the recommendations of SEAC, and decided to issue amendment to the Environmental Clearance. Hence, the following amendments are made to the EC order issued vide reference 1st cited:

- (a) The mining capacity of Colour Granite mentioned under Para no. I shall be read as “**17,061 m³/Annum**”.
- (b) The capital investment of the project mentioned in Para no. I shall be read as “**Rs.55.0 Lakhs**”
- (c) The total mine lease area mentioned in Para no. II shall be read as “**9.4 Ha.**”
- (d) The Life of Mine mentioned in Para no. II and in condition no. i under B. General conditions shall be read as “**33 years**”.

(e) The condition no. i. mentioned in b) Water Pollution under A. Specific conditions: shall be read as:

“The source of water is through tankers from nearby village. Total water requirement is 12.1 KLD. Out of that, 5.6 KLD is used for Wet drilling operations; 5.1 KLD is used for Water Sprinkling on haul roads; 1.0 KLD is used for Domestic Purpose; 0.4 KLD is used for development of green belt. Wastewater generated from the domestic section is to be disposed into septic tank followed by soak pit.”

(f) The condition no. xii. mentioned in B. General Conditions shall be read as:

“The funds earmarked for environmental protection measures (Capital cost of Rs. 5.86 lakhs & Recurring cost of Rs. 2.72 lakhs/annum) should be kept in separate account and should not be diverted for other purpose. Out of which, 10% of the EMP Cost shall be allocated towards development of greenbelt, as committed by the proponent vide Undertaking dt. Nil received on 14.03.2017. Year wise expenditure should be reported to the Ministry and its Regional Office located at Chennai”.

(g) The following additional conditions are inserted under B. General Conditions after condition no. xxi

xxii. The environment safeguards contained in the EMP Report should be implemented in letter and spirit. The responsibility of implementation of environmental safeguards rests fully with the proponent i.e., M/s. Geetha Sri Granites.

xxiii. All the conditions, liabilities and legal provisions contained in the EC shall be equally applicable to the successor management of the project in the event of the project proponent transferring the ownership, maintenance of management of the project to any other entity.

IV. All other information mentioned and conditions stipulated in the EC order issued vide reference 1st cited remain the same.
