1. **WHEREAS**, you are operating the industry located at Sy. No. 247/B, Kollur (V), R.C. Puram (M), Sangareddy District which is within the 10 km radius of Osmansagar and Himayatsagar lakes and engaged in manufacture of Angles by using Steel Ingots as raw material.
2. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 1st cited, the Board issued closure order to your industry for not taking adequate pollution control measures and causing pollution in the surrounding area.
3. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 2nd cited, the Board issued temporary revocation of closure order to your industry for a period of three months i.e. upto 09.01.2016 and subsequently further extended from time to time vide reference 3rd, 4th, 5th 6th & 7th cited.
4. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 8th cited, the industry was issued with CFO&HWA order with a validity upto 31.05.2028 for manufacture of 6 mm MS rounds & 8 mm CTD bars - 15 TPD.
5. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 9th cited, the Board issued Extension of Temporary Revocation of Closure Order to the industry on 28.01.2019 for a period of Six Months with certain directions to comply with.
6. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 10th cited, the industry submitted a representation to the Board on 10.07.2019 for permanent revocation of closure order.
7. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 11th cited, the Board officials inspected the industry on 04.11.2019 and stating the following:
 - During the inspection the industry was in operation, Sri Sanjeev Kumar Mishra, Managing Partner of the industry was present and accompanied.

8. **WHEREAS**, after careful consideration of the material facts of the case, the Board hereby **issue Extension of Temporary Revocation of Closure Orders to your industry for another period of Six Months with following directions to comply:**
1. The industry shall comply CFO&HWA conditions scrupulously.
 2. The industry shall comply with all the directions stipulated in the extension of temporary revocation of closure order dated:28.01.2019.
 3. The industry shall extend the validity of Bank Guarantee of Rs.1.0 Lakh submitted to the Board from time to time till further orders of the Board.
9. **WHEREAS**, the TSSPDC., Ltd., has been directed to restore the power supply to the industry for another period of six months from the date of this order.
10. These directions are issued under Sec.33 (A) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and section 31(A) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987.
11. You are hereby directed to note that, should you misuse these orders to operate the unit violating any of the conditions mentioned above , your unit will be closed under section 33(A) of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and section 31(A) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987 and you will also be liable for prosecution in the court of Metropolitan Magistrate or Judicial Magistrate of the first class under section 41(2) of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 & under section 37(1) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987 the punishment for which includes imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than one year six months and which may be extended to six years with fine.

In the 1st reference mentioned above, under section 33(A) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 & under section 31(A) of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987 orders were issued to TSSPDCL for extension of temporary restoration of power supply for a period of six months to **M/s. Anil Re-rolling Mill, Sy.No. 247/B, Kollur (V), R.C. Puram (M), Sangareddy District.**

In the 2nd reference cited, the industry submitted a representation to the Board requesting for revocation of closure order.

After careful consideration of all the material facts of the case, it was decided to extend the temporary revocation of closure orders for a period of Six Months issued to the industry. Accordingly, the Board issued extension of temporary revocation of closure orders to the industry vide reference 3rd cited. A copy of the extension of temporary revocation of closure order is herewith enclosed.

In view of the above, the Board hereby directs the TSSPDCL to extend the temporary restoration of the power supply to **M/s. Anil Re-rolling Mill, Sy. No. 247/B, Kollur (V), R.C. Puram (M), Sangareddy District for further Six Months from the date of this order** for carrying out the production activities. These directions are issued under section 33(A) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and 31(A) of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987.
