

TSPCB - M/s. Venkateswara Fibre Glass Products, Plot No. 6, Rural Industrial Estate, Alipur (V), Zaheerabad (M), Sangareddy District - Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987 -Industry's request for revocation of closure order - Extension of Temporary Revocation Of Closure Orders for a period of Three Months - Orders Issued - Reg.

- 1. **WHEREAS**, you are operating the industry located at Plot No.6, RIE, Zaheerabad (M), Sangareddy District, is manufacturing fibre reinforced plastic products.
- 2. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited, the industry was inspected on 26.03.2019, by the Joint Team constituted by Hon'ble NGT, Principal Bench, New Delhi in Appeal No.141 -170 of 2018 and observed that the industry was being operated without obtaining Consents of the Board. The team also observed the following violations, during inspection:
  - 1. The industry has dumped Fibre Glass waste outside its compound wall.
  - 2. The industry is illegally discharging its process and domestic effluents within and outside the premises.
  - 3. The industry is carrying out Open spraying of paint without control equipment leading to fugitive emissions and odour.
- 3. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited, the ZO-RC Puram Officials issued Closure Orders to the industry on 08.07.2019 for operating the industry without consent of the Board.
- 4. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited, the industry has obtained CFO Order vide dated:24.02.2020 for a period upto 31.08.2020.
- 5. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited, the Board issued Temporary Revocation of Closure Order to the industry on 28.10.2019 for a period of Three Months, with certain directions to comply with.
- 6. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 5<sup>th</sup> cited, the industry submitted a representation to the Board on 29.02.2020 requested for revocation of Closure Order.
- 7. **WHEREAS**, vide reference 6<sup>th</sup> cited, the Board Officials inspected the industry on 22.02.2020 and submitted a report, the following observation were made:
  - During inspection Sri Santosh, Incharge of the industry, was present and accompanied.

• Compliance of the industry on directions issued vide Temporary revocation of Closure Order, dated 28.10.2019, is as follows:

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- 8. WHEREAS, after careful consideration of the material facts of the case, the Board hereby issue Extension of Temporary Revocation of Closure Orders for a period of Three Months to your industry with following directions to comply with:
  - 1. The industry shall not operate without CFO&HWA of the Board.
  - 2. The industry shall comply with the all the conditions stipulated in the CFO & HWA scrupulously.
  - 3. The industry shall reuse fibre glass waste in the process and shall not dump any fibre waste outside the industry premises under any circumstances.

- 4. The industry shall regularly operate the air pollution control equipment i.e, scrubber connected to the painting section to control the fugitive emissions.
- 5. The industry shall not cause any air pollution / odour nuisance in the surrounding areas.
- 6. The industry shall not discharge any waste water outside the industry premises under any circumstances.
- 7. The industry shall maintain good housekeeping in and around the premises.
- 8. The industry shall install separate energy meter to the air pollution control equipment.
- 9. **WHEREAS,** the TSSPDC., Ltd., has been directed to restore the power supply to your industry for a period of three months from the date of this order.
- 10. These directions are issued under Sec.33 (A) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and section 31(A) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment act, 1987.
- 11. You are hereby directed to note that, should you misuse these orders to operate the unit violating any of the conditions mentioned above, your unit will be closed under section 33(A) of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and section 31(A) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment act, 1987 and you will also be liable for prosecution in the court of Metropolitan Magistrate or Judicial Magistrate of the first class under section 41(2)of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and under section 37(1) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987 the punishment for which includes imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than one year six months and which may be extended to six years with fine.

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In the  $1^{\text{st}}$  reference mentioned above, orders under section 33(A) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and under section 31(A) of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987 were issued to TSSPDCL to restore the power supply for a period of three months to M/s. Venkateswara Fibre Glass Products, Plot No. 6, Rural Industrial Estate, Alipur (V), Zaheerabad (M), Sangareddy District.

In the  $2^{nd}$  reference cited, the industry submitted a representation to the Board requesting for revocation of closure order.

After careful consideration of all the material facts of the case, it was decided to issue extension of temporary revocation of closure orders to the industry for period of three months. Accordingly, the Board issued extension of temporary revocation of closure orders to the industry vide reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited. A copy of the extension of temporary revocation of closure order is herewith enclosed.

In view of the above, the Board hereby directs the TSSPDCL to restore the power supply to M/s. Venkateswara Fibre Glass Products, Plot No. 6, Industrial Estate, Alipur (V), Zaheerabad (M), Sangareddy District for carrying out the production activities. These directions are issued under section 33(A) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and under section 31(A) of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987.
