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1. WHEREAS, you are operating the industry located at D.No. 9-15 and Sy.No. 1/5 & 1/6, Lakshmidivipalli (V & M), Bhadradi Kothagudem District and engaged in production of raw rice - 13.5 TPD using raw paddy of 20 TPD
2. WHEREAS, the Board issued closure orders to the unit vide order dated 10.12.2019 for operating without valid CFE & CFO of the Board.
3. WHEREAS, the Board issued CFO to your unit vide order dated 10.03.2020 which is valid upto 31.10.2020 on submission of commitment letter for shifting of the steamed rice mill within two years.
4. WHEREAS, vide letter dated 17.03.2020, you have requested the Board for revocation of closure orders stating that the unit is carrying our Government custom rice milling and having lot of raw paddy issued by the Government.
5. WHEREAS, the Board officials inspected your unit on 17.03.2020 and observed the compliance as follows:
  - i. The industry has reported that they obtained permission from the Panchayat in 1979.
  - ii. The industry also reported that they installed dryer for drying of raw paddy for which boiler was installed and also installed steamed tanks (8 Nos.) to produce steam rice of capacity of 13.5 TPD in existing raw rice mill by injecting steam to the raw paddy in the vessel for about 5 minutes. No paddy soaking operations are proposed.
  - iii. The industry representative informed that the Boiler is required for drying of raw paddy because of the farmers are selling the paddy having high moisture due to machine cutting of paddy crop and installed steamed process for viability of the rice mill. Hence, they installed and commissioned the steam rice mill unit in August 2019.
  - iv. The unit has not obtained CFE and CFO from the Board for installation of boiler.
  - v. The industry has submitted a commitment letter on Rs.100/- Non Judicial stamp paper that they will remove the steam rice mill unit within two years period and also given commitment that they will remove the steam rice mill unit in case of not meeting the emissions standards prescribed by the TSPCB and also in case of any complaints against the rice mill regarding pollution problems.
  - vi. They also informed that they procured lot of raw paddy from the farmers and required to pay amounts to them and they are continuously keeping pressure on the industry for payment due to stoppage of running of rice mill. They are not getting any private loans due to stoppage of rice mill and this will leads to highly damage to their livelihood and also for their life.
  - vii. The industry was not in operation due to power disconnection. Rice paddy of about 500 Tonnes was stocked in the industry premises.
  - viii. The industry installed boiler of capacity 2 TPH for drying of raw paddy to remove moisture and also inject steam to the raw paddy so as to produce steamed rice. They are provided dust collectors as air pollution control equipment and stack of height of about 90 ft. Earlier, the industry was directed to provide port hole with platform and ladder to the chimney to conduct stack monitoring. During

inspection, it was observed that they provided port hole with platform and ladder to the chimney.

- ix. The industry has provided closed room for collection and storage of Boiler ash. No ash was stored openly as observed at the time of inspection. The industry generates solid waste i.e. Boiler ash - 1 TPD and the same is disposed to brick units. They also provided closed husk room before final disposal of husk.
- x. The industry has utilizes the water of 4.0 KLD of for Boiler feed. No process effluents are to be generated as there are no paddy soaking operations and steam will be injected to the paddy feed vessel for about 5 minutes. Only boiler blow down of about 0.2 KLD and domestic effluent of 0.3 KLD is generated. Boiler blow down is used for ash suppression and domestic effluent is disposed into septic tank.
- xi. The industry is having 125 KVA DG set with acoustic enclosure and provided chimney vent of 6 ft.
- xii. The industry is having few plants in the premises and they planted new saplings in vacant area within the industry premises.

6. WHEREAS, after careful consideration of all the material facts of the case, the Board hereby revokes the Closure Orders issued to your industry with following conditions :

- i. The unit shall comply with all the CFO conditions issued by the Board.
- ii. The unit shall not cause any air pollution is the surroundings due to the operations of the unit

7. The T.S.N.P.D.C.L has been directed to restore the power supply to your unit.

8. These orders are issued under Section 33(A) of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and under section 31(A) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987.

9. You are hereby directed to note that, should you misuse these orders to operate the unit violating any of the conditions mentioned above, your unit will be closed under section 33(A) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and section 31(A) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987. You will also be liable for prosecution in the court of Metropolitan Magistrate or Judicial Magistrate of the first class under section 41(2) of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and under section 37(1) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987, the punishment for which includes imprisonment for a term which shall not be less than one year six months and which may be extended to six years with fine.

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In the 1<sup>st</sup> reference mentioned above, orders under section 33(A) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and under section 31(A) of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987 were issued to T.S.N.P.D.C.L to disconnect the power supply to M/s Sri Venkateswara Rice & Flour Mill, D.No. 9-15 and Sy.No. 1/5 & 1/6, Lakshmidivipalli (V & M), Bhadradi Kothagudem District.

In the 2<sup>nd</sup> reference cited, the industry has requested for permanent revocation of closure orders. After careful consideration of all facts of the case, the Board has decided to revoke the closure orders issued to the industry.

The Board hereby directs the T.S.N.P.D.C.L to restore the power supply to M/s Sri Venkateswara Rice & Flour Mill, D.No. 9-15 and Sy.No. 1/5 & 1/6, Lakshmidivipalli (V & M), Bhadradi Kothagudem District for carrying out the production activities. These directions are issued under section 33(A) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988 and under section 31(A) of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1987.
