The SEIAA discussed the recommendations of the SEAC in detail and noted that the project is proposed within 10 km radius of Himayat Sagar and Osman Sagar Lakes on the downstream side and also the above project does not fall in the list of 84 villages in the 10km catchment of above lakes as mentioned in the G.O.Ms. No: 111, MA, dt. 08.03.1996. Hence, the SEIAA considered the project and approved the project for issue of Environmental Clearance subject to submission of undertaking on following issues:

- They will satisfactorily increase their investment w.r.t. greenbelt.
- They will not discharge any wastewater outside the premises until their project's outlet is connected to public sewer line. Till such time, they will be responsible to recycle 100% of their wastewater generated within their project.
- They will conform to the WALTA Act and their water consumption will be as per the permissions granted by the concerned authorities.
- They will adopt Green Building Concepts, use renewable energy by adopting Energy Conservation Practices, Energy efficient practices & energy audit practices, etc.,
