of revised Action Plan for PIII to PV Stretches**

At the outset, the Member Secretary, TSPCB informed the committee about the communication received from CPCB dated:14.03.2019 with suggestion to revise action plan report of P-III to P-V stretches covering all aspects in line with P-I & P-II stretches action plan report. The revised action plan reports of PIII to PV stretches prepared by NEERI have to be examined by RRC for finalizing and subsequently forwarding to CPCB and also for apprising to Hon'ble NGT.

Dr. Basha, Scientist, NEERI made a presentation to the RRC on the revised action plans prepared with the inputs received from the Irrigation, Public Health and Ground Water Depts, for the polluted river stretches of PIII, PIV and PV.

It was informed to the committee that the action plan of Kinnerasani (PIV stretch) and Karakavagu (PIII stretch) were merged and the revised action plan of Kinnerasani-Karakavagu is prepared accordingly.

The Chairman of RRC and Chief Secretary, Govt. of Telangana directed to designate a nodal officer from each of the responsible organizations for implementing the action plans as per the time limit specified in the revised action plan report.

The Member Secretary informed the committee that as per the direction of Hon'ble NGT during the hearing held on 08.04.2019, the upper limit for execution of the action plans will be two years from 01.04.2019 (i.e., upto 01.04.2021).

The committee also noted the revised criteria for performance guarantees mentioned in the Hon'ble NGT order dated: 08.04.2019 which is Rs.10 crores for the Telangana State (between 5 to 10 stretches).

The committee approved the revised action plans of PIII, PIV and PV stretches and directed for the submission to CPCB and apprise to Hon'ble NGT.
