

PROCEDURE FOR PROCESSING OF CONSENT FOR OPERATION (CFO), HAZARDOUS WASTE AUTHORISATION, E-WASTE AUTHORISATION, PLASTIC WASTE REGISTRATION, SOLID WASTE AUTHORISATION AND CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION WASTE AUTHORISATION APPLICATION BY TELANGANA STATE POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD (TSPCB)

1 Consent under Water [Prevention & Control of Pollution] Act, 1974 and its amendments (CFO):

As per section 25 of the Water [Prevention & Control of Pollution] Act, 1974 as amended, no person shall without the previous consent of the State Board, establish or take any steps to establish any industry operation or process or any treatment and disposal system or any extension or addition thereto which is likely to discharge sewage or trade effluent into any stream or well or sewer or on-land. As per Sub Section 2 of Section 25 of the said Act, an application for consent of the State Board under Sub Section [1] shall be made in such form and contain such particulars and shall be accompanied by such fees as may be prescribed.

Consent under Air [Prevention & Control of Pollution] Act, 1981 and its amendments (CFO):

As per Section 21 of the Air [Prevention & Control of Pollution] Act, 1981 as amended, no person shall without the previous consent of the State Board, establish or operate any industrial plant for the purpose of any industry specified in an Air Pollution Control area. As per Sub section [2] of section 21 of the said Act, an application for consent of the State Board under Sub section [1] shall be accompanied by such fees as may be prescribed and shall be made in the prescribed form and shall contain the particulars of the industrial plant and such other particulars as may be prescribed.

Authorisation under Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 (HWA):

As per the Rule (6), Every occupier of the facility who is engaged in handling, generation, collection, storage, packaging, transportation, use, treatment, processing, recycling, recovery, pre-processing, co-processing, utilisation, offering for sale, transfer or disposal of the hazardous and other wastes shall be required to make an application in Form 1 to the State Pollution Control Board and obtain an authorisation from the State Pollution Control Board.

Authorisation under E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016 (EWA):

As per the Rule (13), Every Manufacturer and Refurbisher of Electrical and Electronic Equipment (EEE), E-Waste Recyclers & Dismantlers are required to obtain authorisation for generation, storage, transportation, treatment and disposal of E-Waste. The manufacturers and refurbishers have to make application in Form 1(a) and E-Waste Recycler & Dismantlers have to make

application in Form-4 to the State Pollution Control Board to obtain Authorisation.

Registration under Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 (PWR):

As per the Rule (13), Every Producers manufacturing / importing Plastic carry bags or multilayered packaging or Plastic sheets or like & Brand Owners (Having manufacturing facility in the State) using multilayered plastic sachet or pouches and Plastic Waste Recyclers have to obtain Registration. The Producers & Brand Owners are required to make application in Form-I and Plastic Waste Recyclers are required to make application in Form-II to the State Pollution Control Board to obtain Registration.

Authorisation under Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 (SWA):

As per the Rule 15 (y), 21(3) and 16(1), every local body or an operator of facility or an agency designated by them proposing to set up waste processing, treatment, disposal facility or waste to energy plant of more than five tones per day processing capacity shall submit an application in Form-I to the State Pollution Control Board or Pollution Control Committee, as the case may be, for authorisation.

Authorisation under Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016 (C&D-A):

As per the Rule 7(2), every operator of the C&D facility as specified in sub- rules (1), i.e., the site for storage and processing or recycling facilities for construction and demolition waste shall be selected as per the criteria given in Schedule 1 of the Rules, shall apply in Form I for authorisation from State Pollution Control Board or Pollution Control Committee.

The Telangana State Pollution Control Board (TSPCB) enforces the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and its amendments, Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and its amendments and the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Rules made thereunder.

The industries have to apply for Consent for Operation (CFO) under the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and its amendments and Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and its amendments and authorisations under Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 (*if applicable*), Authorisation under E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016 (*if applicable*), Registration under Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 (*if applicable*), Authorisation under Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 (*if applicable*) and Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016 (*if applicable*) at a time online through TS-iPASS. **The TSPCB is issuing single CFO , HWA, EWA, PWR,**

	<u>SWA and C&D-A order to the industries.</u>
2	<p>TSPCB has implemented Online Consent Management & Monitoring System developed by NIC, New Delhi since November 2015 and it is integrated with TS-iPASS.</p> <p>All the applicants need to register themselves in the TS-iPASS: https://ipass.telangana.gov.in/ or Online Consent Management System (OCMMS): http://tsocmms.nic.in/TLNPCB/</p> <p>The applicants shall fill-up the information related to the application for consent for operation, Hazardous Waste Authorisation (if applicable), E-Waste Authorisation (if applicable), Plastic Waste Registration (if applicable), Solid Waste Authorisation (if applicable), and Construction & Demolition Waste Authorisation (if applicable) in the online application form.</p> <p>The system is designed in such a way that based on the information filled-in, the system will generate statutory application forms under Water Act, Air Act, Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016, E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016, Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016, Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 and Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016.</p> <p>There is no fee applicable for eWaste, Plastic Waste, Solid Waste, and C&D Waste Authorisations only.</p> <p>The applicant has to pay fee for Consent for Operation through on-line payment. The system will generate online fee receipt.</p>
3	<p>The application submitted for consent for operation, HWA, EWA, PWR, SWA and C&D-A will be routed to the concerned Regional officer. There are 10 Regional Offices in the State of Telangana.</p> <p>The Regional Officer will forward the application to the concerned Assistant Environmental Engineer for scrutiny.</p>
4	<p>The Assistant Environmental Engineer (AEE) will scrutinize the online application and related documents, adequacy of consent fee paid. He/she will put his/her observations especially on adequacy of information etc., in the notes and forward to the Regional officer.</p>

5	<p>The Regional officer will scrutinize the application and observations of AEE and may raise clarification to the industry online, if the information furnished by the industry is not adequate. Simultaneously, inspection will be carried out for early disposal of the application and to avoid delay.</p>
6	<p>The assigned officials of Regional office will conduct inspection of the industry and conduct monitoring of stack emission, ambient air quality, analysis of effluent samples etc. as per the standard procedure in vogue. They will also verify compliance with the conditions stipulated in CFO, HWA (if applicable), EWA (if applicable), PWR (if applicable), SWA (if applicable) and C&D-A (if applicable). Directions issued if any. The inspection report will be submitted online and forwarded to the Regional Officer.</p>
7	<p>The Regional Officer will offer his remarks on the application. The inspection report with RO remarks will be placed before the consent clearance committees at Board office / Zonal Office / Regional Office as per the delegated powers.</p> <p>The delegated powers are available at http://tspcb.cgg.gov.in/pages/delegationpowers.aspx</p>
8	<p>AT BOARD OFFICE:--</p> <p>The Regional Officer will forward the inspection report to the Board office through online.</p> <p>The concerned officers at Board office (AEE/EE/SEE) shall scrutinize the application technically with respect to emission details, discharge details, production capacities, status of pollution control measures, compliance to CFE conditions/CFO, HWA, EWA, PWR, SWA and C&D-A conditions / TF Directions (if any), Conditions of Environmental Clearance issued by MoEF/SEIAA, Telangana State (if applicable).</p> <p>An agenda note will be prepared based on the observations in the inspection reports and other remarks and it is available online to the users (applicants).</p> <p>The agenda note will be placed before the CFO committee for examination and recommendations.</p> <p>The recommendations of the committee will be uploaded in online system.</p> <p>Based on the recommendations of the Committee, the Board will issue CFO, HWA, EWA, PWR, SWA and C&D-A through a single order.</p> <p>The order is made available to the industry online.</p>

9	<p>AT ZONAL OFFICES:-</p> <p>The Regional Officer will forward the inspection report to the concerned Zonal office through online.</p> <p>The concerned officers at Zonal office (AEE/EE/SEE) will scrutinize the application technically with respect to emission details, discharge details, production capacities, status of pollution control measures, compliance to CFE conditions/ CFO, HWA, PWR, SWA and C&D-A conditions / TF Directions (if any), Conditions of Environmental Clearance issued by MoEF/SEIAA, Telangana State (<i>if applicable</i>).</p> <p>An agenda note will be prepared based on the observations in the inspection reports and other remarks and it is available online to the users (applicants).</p> <p>The agenda note will be placed before the CFO committee for examination and recommendations.</p> <p>The recommendations of the committee will be uploaded in online system.</p> <p>Based on the recommendations of the Committee, the Zonal office will issue CFO, HWA, PWR, SWA, and C&D-A through a single order, as per the delegation of powers.</p> <p>The order is made available to the industry online.</p>

Furnishing of information in online application of Consent for operation, Hazardous Waste Authorisation (*if applicable*), E-Waste Authorisation (*if applicable*), Plastic Waste Registration (*if applicable*), Solid Waste Authorisation (*if applicable*) and Construction and Demolition Waste Authorisation (*if applicable*).
2. Latest audited balance sheet.
3. Adequate fees prescribed for consent for operation based on project cost as per audited balance sheet (fixed assets without depreciation).
4. Compliance with the conditions stipulated in consent for establishment (CFE) issued by the Board in case of 1ST time consent for operation application.
5. In case of renewal of Consent for operation, Hazardous Waste Authorisation (*if applicable*), E-Waste Authorisation (*if applicable*) Plastic Waste Registration (*if applicable*), Solid Waste Authorisation (*if applicable*) and Construction and Demolition Waste Authorisation (*if applicable*), compliance status on the conditions stipulated in previous order/ Directions issued, if any.
6. Copy of Environmental Clearance issued by Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF&CC) / State Environmental Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) (*if applicable*).
7. Latest layout map of the factory. (Clearly showing location of Pollution Control Systems).
8. Process flow chart and detailed manufacturing process.
9. Copy of latest Environmental Management Plan (EMP).
10. Further documents for Authorisation under Solid Waste Management Rules:
 - Site clearance (local body)
 - Agreement between municipal authority and operational agency
 - Processing/ Recycling/ Treatment of solid waste:
 - Utilization program for waste processed (Product utilization)
 - Methodology for disposal
 - Quantity of leachate treatment technology for leachate
 - Measures to be taken for prevention and control of environmental pollution
 - Measures to be taken for safety of workers working in the plant

- Details of solid waste processing/recycling/treatment/disposal facility
 - Disposal of solid waste:
 - Details of methodology or criteria followed for site selection
 - Details of existing site under operation Methodology and operational details of landfilling
